The Net Zero Neighbourhoods (NZN) initiative in the West Midlands is ramping up, and we're thrilled to share the latest developments and opportunities with you! As our programme transitions towards the delivery phase, now is the perfect time to showcase what we've been up to and how you can get involved in shaping a more sustainable future.

## What is a Net Zero Neighbourhood?

A Net Zero Neighbourhood is community where, through integrated strategies like demand reduction, clean energy generation, low-carbon or active travel projects, and enhancing public green spaces, emissions are minimised. At the heart of this initiative is community co-production, citizens take an active role in codesigning their community's journey to Net Zero. This grassroots approach ensures that the vision for each neighbourhood is inclusive and tailored specific requirements aspirations of local people.

#### What We've Achieved So Far

Since the programme launched in 2021, we've made significant progress:

- Seven Net Zero Neighbourhood plans have been developed—one for each of our constituent local authorities
- The Brockmoor project in Dudley is in the delivery phase, supported by £1.6 million in funding from the West Midlands Combined Authority (WMCA).
- Our work has played a critical role in securing additional funding, including support from the Department for Energy Security and Net Zero (DESNZ) to lead a Local Net Zero Accelerator (LNZA).

from With funding the LNZA programme, we're expanding even further. Six Net more Zero Neighbourhoods in Birmingham, Coventry, Sandwell, Solihull, Walsall, and Wolverhampton are set to begin with community engagement activities to codesign projects with local citizens.
