# WMCA Citizen's Panel: Retrofit and Devolution



### Why retrofit?



### **WM2041**

- Residential properties account for 17-21% of global emissions
- 1.1 million homes in the region need efficiency improvements

### **Fuel Poverty**

- Estimated 235,512 fuel poor homes in the region
- Highest rates in the country, over 40% of homes in some areas

#### **Additional Outcomes**

#### **Health:**

- 10% of excess winter deaths are directly attributable to fuel poverty
- A fifth of excess winter deaths are attributable to the coldest quarter of homes

## What we're working on



### **Capacity building**

- Bidding for funding from government
- Advising and supporting partners
- Representing region's needs to government

However, government funding is often short term and doesn't meet our region's needs.

# **Demonstrator projects**

- Managing delivery of retrofit projects
- Seeking to improve quality of work taken
- Gathering useful learning

# Market development support

- Engaging supply chain to understand opportunities and needs
- Understanding housing stock and customer needs
- Seeking funding to help overcome barriers

### What's next - Devolution



### **Context**

- March 2023 Trailblazer Devolution Deal agreed
- Commitment to pilot a single, multi-year funding agreement for the region, including funding for retrofit
- We are now consulting on the terms of the single funding settlement

# Why pursue devolved funding?

#### **Current roadblocks**

- Funding is short-term and difficult to complete projects in timescales
- Stop start funding doesn't give installers confidence
- Focus of projects can be too restrictive – excluding certain homes or types of work

# What we want devolved funding to achieve

- More flexibility in terms of which homes and types of work can be funded
- More of a focus on real world performance – i.e. does it actually work
- Ability to bring in more funding – e.g. private finance
- Use some funding to remove barriers that stop retrofit from happening
